

#### Welcome to the 2008-2009 Speedcar Super Series

Racing in conjunction with the Victorian, Queensland, South Australian and New South Wales Speedcar clubs; the Super Series returns for another year of superb Speedcar racing.

# SERIES REGULATIONS

- Rules from the current Speedcars Australia rule book will be enforced.
- Nomination monies must be paid and Code of Conduct form signed prior to the Driver participating in the Time Trial draw or taking their Speedcar on to the track.
- Contracted drivers must compete in all 6 rounds of the Series to be eligible for the Championship prize money. A driver will not be affected if a round is cancelled by SSS administration.
- Every competitor at every race track must display decals (supplied by SSS officials) on each down tube.
- Any contracted driver that suffers from unforeseen adverse circumstances may choose to substitute themselves with another driver for a maximum of one round, with the original driver receiving any points earned.
- If the driver completes all qualifying and changes his car for the A/B features, the driver will start ROF in their qualifying feature.
- Notification of any driver change must be given to SSS administration <u>48 hours prior</u> to the event. Phone:

## **RACE REGULATIONS**

- Compulsory drivers briefing at 4.30pm.
- Cars must be on the track for engine starts and wheel packing no later than 5.30pm. Please note: subject to change according to promoter requests, please check the SSS site for updates.
- Speedcars will hot lap as per groups allocated at the drivers briefing, no swapping hot lap groups.

# TIME TRIALS

- The time trial order will be drawn at the drivers briefing; consecutive laps, taking the best single lap. Any driver who time trials out of order shall receive one lap only at the end and cannot time trial any better than eleventh place (11th).
- Park between the cone markers in time trial order, cars will be push started from this grid.
- In the event of two drivers setting the exact time, the driver that did it first shall be deemed the highest qualifier.
- Should time trails be cancelled for any reason, the format shall revert to drivers being seeded into three equal heats, with the first round of heats marble drawn and second round inverted.
- If a driver changes cars after qualifying, the driver will revert to zero points and start ROF in the heats.

## HEATS

- Each driver to compete in two rounds of heats, 10 laps each.
- Three heats per round to be divided equally as per time trial results.
  - Fastest time trial into heat 3, second fastest into heat 2, third fastest into heat 1, with the fourth fastest into heat 3, fifth fastest into heat 2, so on and so forth.
  - Heats will be an inverted starting order as per time trial results ie. Highest qualifier/fastest time to the rear.
- Each driver to receive one inside row start and one outside row start.
- Second round of heats:
  - Heat 4 outside row Heat 2 and inside row heat 1.
  - Heat 5 outside row Heat 1 and inside row heat 3.
  - Heat 6 outside row Heat 3 and inside row heat 2. If the car count is greater than 36, an extra heat will be allocated.
- Points allocation as per points table.
- DNF receive NO points (rule 3.5.1 exception) as per S/Aus.
- At the end of all heat competition, if there is a tie on points, the faster time shall be deemed higher.

# POLE SHUFFLE

- Top eight point scorers to compete in pole shuffle.
- The higher qualifier has the lane choice.
- Winner of the pole shuffle has lane choice for the final.

## **B** MAIN

- Distance to be set by SSS Officials.
- First four placings to start in finishing order from 17-20 in the A main.

# A MAIN

- A main will be 30 laps excluding the final round which is 40.
- Starting positions 1-8 as per pole shuffle positions. 9-16 as per points order. Positions 17-20 as per B Main results.
- Points and Prize money for the A main shall be paid from 1-20 regardless of finishing the event or not. NOTE: Chief Steward Discretion re black flag disqualifications. Mechanical flags will be paid prize monies.

## FINAL ROUND

- A main will be 40 laps.
- Prize money has been increased for the final feature race:
  - o 1<sup>st</sup>. \$3000
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup>. \$2000
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup>. \$1000
  - o Normal prize money follows
